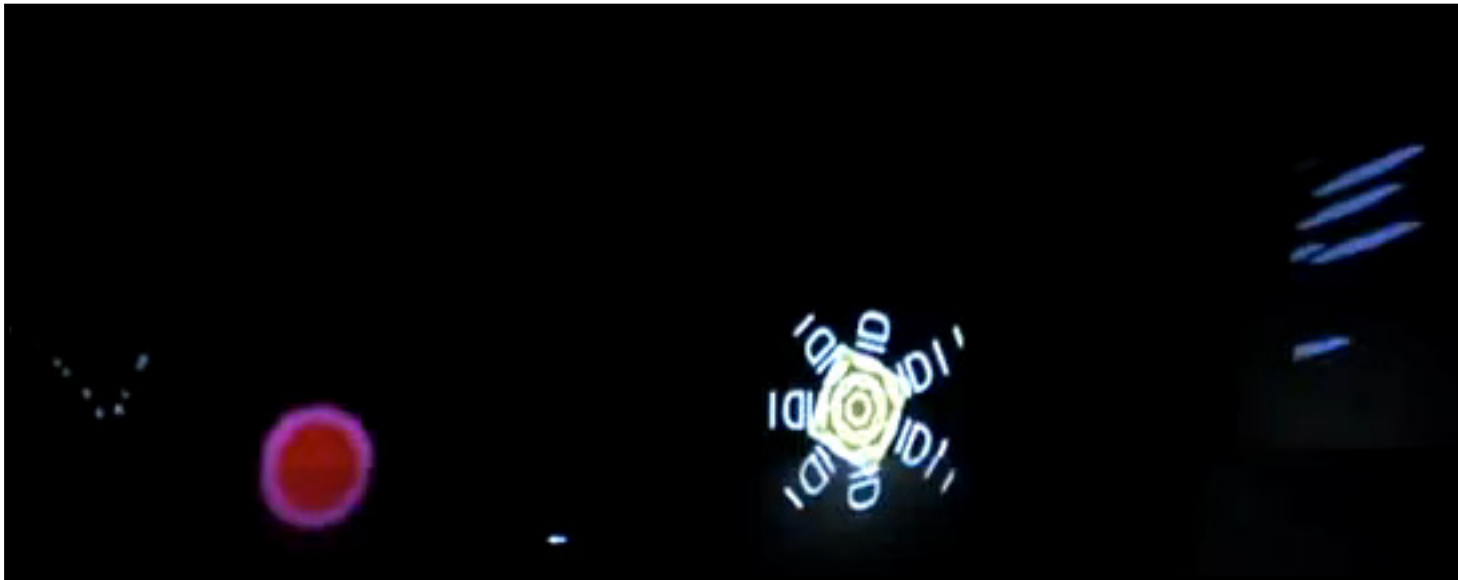

Bandwidth



Bandwidth is a projection art exhibit displayed on three surfaces, designed to be very flexible and scalable. The three surfaces can be as small as a computer monitor in a gallery or as large as the side of a building for outside audiences. The audio component may be reproduced in stereo with a subwoofer, although a 5.1 mix is available. The exhibit blurs the lines of definition between installation and performance as some visual components are controlled by gesture. The size, velocity or other aspect of appearance is controlled by an operator moving their hand to activate the sensor. This makes for an excellent audience participant work as viewers are invited to control one or more parameters of the visual elements to create a unique performance. Sensors can be arranged so that more than one operator can control a visual element allowing for greater numbers of participants.
